ALS - amyotrophic lateral sclerosis, also known as Lou Gehrig's disease - targets brain cells called motor neurons. As motor neurons die, a person progressively loses the ability to walk, speak, swallow, and breathe. ALS affects adults of all ages, from teens to seniors, and is usually fatal within 2-5 years of diagnosis.

Project ALS identifies and funds the most promising scientific research that will lead to the first effective treatments and a cure for ALS.
